

The Valley Bowmen of Huddersfield 2021 GRAND PRIX AWARDS & FUN SHOOT – 3rd OCTOBER 2021

Welcome everyone to the '2021 Grand Prix Awards and Fun Shoot'. I was pleasantly surprised with the numbers attending the fun shoot due to the Covid thing, thank you everyone. Before presenting the awards to those who were successful in the Grand Prix event there was a small fun shoot game or two to be enjoyed by those brave enough. There were two games on offer, Archery Yahtzee and Archery Halves. The adjudicators had to be ever vigilant to ensure there was no tweaking of the rules.

<u>ARCHERY YAHTZEE</u> – Each participant had 8 ends of three arrows each to complete/or not, each element of the game. Could you do well enough to get a 'bonus' score? Probably not, only 3 out of 12 managed the bonus, but all was not lost because scores were carried over to our second game of the day.

<u>ARCHERY HALVES</u> - The game asks the archer to achieve a set task at each end and to be rewarded with stacks of points if successful. If an archer was unsuccessful on a set task the **entire** running total was **halved**, if the next task was unsuccessful the running total was **halved** again and so on. The ensemble was split into four groups, three arrow ends were shot at our happy monster target faces, moving to the right after each end. The underlined bold blue numbers below show who was in first place after the end of each end. You can see from the scores below that the lead can change any time.
