NOTES FROM THE MEETING:

1. Matters arising:

2. Welfare:

3. Finance:

No major changes in our financial situation. The new indoor range will take most of our income over the next 6 months hence there will be little spare cash until then.

4. Scores and Records:

5. Competitions:

The traditional bow shoot will take place on Sunday 24th October. An email has already been sent regarding this competition. This competition will only be held on the day hence no scores will be accepted during the week prior as we have recently been doing.

6. Coaching:

Beginner course 8 is ongoing. Courses 9 & 10 this year and course 1 for next year are fully booked. Course 2 is almost full and course 3 has 9 places remaining.

a) the information requested by Kirklees for the £1000.00 grant received has been accepted and is now signed off.

b) the booking system for shooting at the field will end on the 31st October

c). the handicap improver medal has been issued to Oscar Fenik along with an engraved medal for him to keep. An engraved medal for Mollie Bower is also available.

d) the income from 'easyfundraising' has diminished over the past few months. We would like to encourage members to use this scheme, if at all possible, especially as Christmas is approaching. Last year we raised £250.00 in the 3 month run up to Christmas.

e). regarding the use of the new indoor range members will be able to use the facility between the hours of 8am to 10pm (planning condition!) every day without the need for booking except when the facility is needed for special events/taster sessions/beginner courses/coaching sessions/junior night etc. Alan has set up a separate calendar on the website so all members can see when the range is available. Sunday is one of our club days and may well be popular with members therefore the proposal is to run 2 sessions either in the morning and the afternoon or to have 2 sessions in the afternoon from say 1pm to 3pm and 3pm to 5pm.

There will be costs associated with running the building particularly lighting and heating. To this extent we propose the following charges:

£1.00 per attendance

£3.00 per week

£10.00 per month

£40.00 for the indoor season.

We would like feedback from members to the above charges.
