a) There had been a response from 2 members regarding possible charges for use of the indoor range. Thanks to those two who responded. After some consideration it was decided that

a) the indoor season would commence 1st October and end 31st March annually.

b) In an effort to cover future running costs (it may take 12 months to assess this cost) the charges for a season would be as follows:

£30.00 for a household (1 plus)

£15.00 for a junior member whose parents / guardians do not shoot with him/her.

£1.00 for ad.hoc visits

Although the indoor season is for 6 months during the Autumn and Winter months as noted above it does not prevent members from shooting indoors at any time of the year if they so wish and for the above fees of £30 and £15.00 members can shoot as many times as they wish during the week, provided they use the booking system on

the club website where 8 lanes are available in 2 hour slots Could members bank transfer the fees to the club account.

c) Priority will be given to juniors on a Friday evening for shooting if all 8 lanes are oversubscribed.
