MAJOR PROJECTS: (in order of priority)

2. Guard railing / fencing around the indoor range
3. Car parking provision between pavilion and boundary wall
4. Tarmacking of existing car park area and marking out spaces.

MINOR PROJECTS: (in order of priority)

1. Protection to beam and 2 columns within indoor range (from wayward arrows)
2. Replace broken light fitting on top storage cabin.
3. Repairs to boundary fence at top of field
4. Paving from indoor range emergency exit door to front of building
5. Hardstanding in front of entrance doors to indoor range.
