NOTES FROM THE MEETING:

1.Matters arising:

Any items arising are dealt with in the main agenda

2. Welfare:

Matt has now completed his DBS check. There are 2 more courses for him to complete which the club will pay for.

- a) The number of Junior members and members with a disability was requested by Matt. PMcG to confirm.
- b) As part of the AGB protection of children and vulnerable adults, parents will be requested to sign a consent form for juniors and for consent to photography and filming. Some forms have already been signed. As new juniors join the club then these forms will require to be signed by parents.
- c) Names of people having access to all members in Golden Records requested by Matt. Action AH
- d) Alan H. will create a Welfare Folder on the website for access by Alan H., Mark S and Matt.
- e) Regarding the current financial crisis, the club will consider requests for possible reduced payments at the time of club subscription renewal. Acceptance

will depend on some sort of proof of hardship. For disabled persons we already operate a reduced payment scheme being a £30.00 annual club subscription and reduced AGB insurance.

3.Finance:

Club membership subscriptions now stand at 192 fully paid-up members. Finances are ticking over with income from taster sessions and beginner courses. 167 members have renewed their insurance.

In line with AGB age groups we have agreed to amend the club subscription for members up to the age of 21 to ± 30.00 as from 1st April 2023. Members over the age of 21 will pay the full adult rate of ± 70.00 as from 1st April 2023

It was decided not to charge members for use of the indoor range for this indoor season.

4. Scores and Records:

Scores are being submitted daily and some new records are being set.

The new age group changes came into force on the 1^{st} of October 2022 There are now 16 age groups including new U15, U21 & +50. Any archer can shoot any round. Check with Rules of Shooting which have been updated. For our own internal competitions, we will add the +50 category to the Handicap competition.

5. Competitions:

The club outdoor championship and outdoor Handicap competitions were held on Sunday 4th & 18th September respectively. Reports have been circulated.

The next competition is the Traditional Bow shoot on the 23^{rd} of October (10.30 for 11.00am)

The club will again pay for the team entries into the Winter league.

6. Coaching:

Beginner course no. 9 completed with 2 people joining so far.

Course no. 10 commenced 1st October – Course no. 11 to commence 5th November coaches have been appointed. This is the last course for this year.

From September 2023 the cost of the beginner course will increase from £60.00 to £75.00 pp. including the £10.00 non-refundable deposit. After completion of the course the adult joining fee will increase from £75.00 to £80.00.

It has been suggested that we could hold midweek Beginner courses. However, this means having enough coaches/ volunteers to assist. We would need more volunteers to step forward other than those coaches and members who regularly take these courses. If you think that you would be able to assist (you would have to be DBS checked!) please let the secretary know. The possibility of running midweek evening courses is dependent upon the feedback received. Action All Members

7. Major Projects:

There are several projects to be carried out, some imminently and others when we have the financial resources.

MAJOR PROJECTS: (in order of priority)

- 1. Guard railing / fencing around the indoor range quotes received
- 2. Soil and turf to be laid adjacent retaining system to field side of indoor range.
- 3. Paving from indoor range emergency exit door to front of building
- 4. Hardstanding in front of entrance doors to indoor range.
- 5. Car parking provision between pavilion and boundary wall
- 6. Tarmacking of existing car park area and marking out spaces.

MINOR PROJECTS: (in order of priority)

- 1. Repairs to boundary fence at top of field and repair to fence bottom of field adjacent meter house quote accepted
- 2. Protection to beams and columns within indoor range (from wayward arrows) work in hand due to complete 18th October
- 3. Replace broken light fitting on top storage cabin-work in hand
- 4. Gravel path around indoor range to complete 17th October (working party arranged)
- 5. Fix leaking gutter
- 6. Application of anti-slip paint to decking
- 7. Replace door to meter chamber
