The Traditional Shoot is an event where <u>any</u> Valley Bowmen club member, using <u>any</u> bow style they wish can take part. The event requires that no sights of any kind are used, and also only wooden arrows can be shot, the only other difference is that there are no sighters allowed.

The round for the day was a Western Round, 4 dozen arrows at both 60 yards and 50 yards.

There were 6 participants for this unusual shoot, all hardy (that's one word for it) gentlemen. Three were shooting Recurve, two shooting Longbow and one shooting Flatbow.

Equipment was checked by the field captain to make sure rules were followed, that was me by the way and I still unfortunately found no reasons to disqualify anyone.
