1.Matters arising:

2. Welfare:

A first aid kit has now been fitted in the indoor range. Unfortunately, due to ill health our welfare Officer Matt Labno has had to resign his position which means that currently we do not have a Welfare Officer. In the interim period any member who wishes to raise a welfare issue can approach any member of the committee. Also, Mark and Alan H. will check the welfare officer email address for any messages.

We, therefore, are now advertising for someone to take on this role. If you feel that you could act in this role, then please let a committee member know. Most of the time the role should take up minimal time. However, there are a few AGB webinars to attend to qualify for the role.

3.Finance:

Club membership subscriptions now stand at 203 fully paid-up members. 184 members have renewed their insurance. Our Treasurer, John Dean, will be producing the financial report prior to the AGM for circulation to members.

John also confirmed at the meeting that he will be standing down as Treasurer at the AGM. We are, therefore, advertising for a new Treasurer (which is a committee position) from immediate effect. If you think that you could take on this role then please let a member of the committee know.

When you have completed your round, please upload it to Golden Records asap and please note for the handicap competition you need to have registered 3 scores (not 252's) before the 17th of March.

Winners will be presented with their trophies at the AGM.
