



Outdoor Handicap Club Championships

Sunday 17th September 2023

This year the competition was open to anyone shooting a 12-dozen metric round. A total of 14 archers competed for the trophy under an overcast sky, although the sun did break through on occasion.



Anyone who has previously submitted 3 validated scoring rounds is awarded a handicap allowance. Each archer has their "allowance" added to the score they achieve on the day to give the final competition result. The theory being that if every archer shoots at the level of their handicap on the day, everyone will have a final score of exactly 1,440 (after adding their allowance).

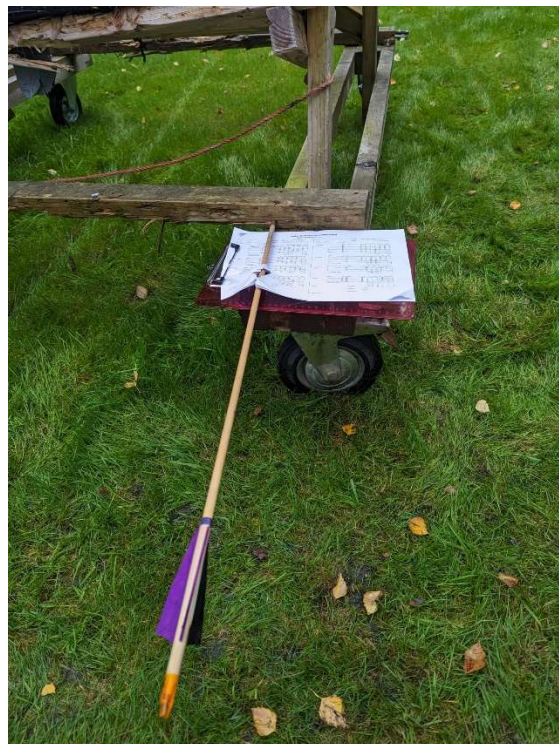




For those competitors that have never seen the view from 90m – this is what it looks like 😊
