#### 1. Matters arising:

b) Club clothing – awaiting feedback

- c) We are considering running a basic first aid course for members which will take around 4 hours. Date to be announced.
- d) We understand that the defibrillator is coming to the end of its life, and it has been suggested that we ask for donations / sponsors for its replacement. If you can help in any way please let a member of the committee know.
- e) 55 members have so far renewed their club subscription.
- f) 35 responses have so far been received regarding the proposed constitutional change and proposed club name change, the results of which will be given at the AGM.

- g) club membership cards will have a green border for 2024/25. It was agreed that for new members a 'probationary' card will be produced which will have a red border.
