NOTES FROM THE MEETING:

1. Matters arising:

2. Welfare:

No issues to raise. Online meetings are being attended by the Welfare Officer.

3. Finance:

5. Competitions:

6. Coaching:

Please register for the next session on the 21st July otherwise no coaches will be present.

Beginner course no. 7 was successfully completed on the 29th June. All courses are now fully booked for the rest of this year. The first course in January 2025 is also fully booked. Bookings are now being taken for February 2025.

There is availability for one other person to attend a coaching course this year.

7. Projects:

MAJOR PROJECTS: (in order of priority)

- 1. Car parking provision between pavilion and boundary wall
- 2. Tarmacking of existing car park area and marking out spaces scheme prepared further discussions to take place. **Action PM**

MINOR PROJECTS: (in order of priority)

- 2 Fix a couple of cameras to the end of the pavilion as dummy cameras only.
- 3. Refix wooden gate post
- 4. Proposed hit & miss type fence discussed to the 'windy corner'.
- A request has been made for a small shed to be located in the recess in the trees around the 100yard marker to house a couple of straw bosses mainly for use by members shooting longbow Committee to consider and to obtain costs.

The Summer fun shoot is scheduled for the 14th July. Due to the new grass being sown we will probably move the shooting line up the field to say, 60 yards therefore for this particular event compound bows will not be able to be used.

- b) The barebow teach -in session occurred on Sunday 9^{th} June. Thanks to the members who spoke and demonstrated this style of shooting and to the coaches / members who attended.
- c) The following Taster / Have a go sessions are scheduled over the coming weeks: Friday 19th July 2.30pm to 4.30pm. corporate session 8 people. 3 coaches so far. One other would be helpful.
