a) whistle stop tour have a go raised £12.00. Picnic in the park have a go raised £89.00.

b) A list of first aiders is now formulated on Golden Records. If any of our members who are first aiders e.g. with their jobs and are willing to support the club also, could they please let us know.

c) Certain ‘field tidy’ jobs to complete. – repaint gate – replace faulty PIR ext. light fitting.

d) AGB membership changes –for this year members should pay through the club as follows.

e) After having a random incident recently where a stranger came into the field wanting to shoot it has been suggested that a sign be erected with possible wording - “Private Property – Members and Invited Guests Only”

f) There have been some complaints regarding members smoking or vaping near the shooting line. Could we ask members who wish to smoke that no smoking or vaping is carried out in front (field side) of the pavilion.

g) In some of our recent competitions it has been noticed after the event that some scores have not been added up correctly. In future competitions, therefore, the following is suggested:

1. Individual archers are responsible for checking that scores have been recorded and added up correctly, so if they have signed the scoresheet (even if wrong) that is what we use for the results. After the event when submitted to Golden Records if a score is a new Club Record, then Graham will check the score and adjust accordingly if an error is found – but this would not alter the results of the competition.
2. At each distance change, scorers swap scoresheets and validate the mathematics. Thus, at the end of a shoot when the final distance has been validated the TO can proceed as in 1. above and simply take the signed results as correct.
